



**Jackson County Central Schools**  
**1:1 Student Device Program Policies and Guidelines**  
**Student and Parent Agreement**  
**September 2017 – June 2018**

Technology, including school computers, Interactive Whiteboards, Chromebooks and iPads have been implemented into Jackson County Schools for educational purposes. Access to this technology may be revoked at any time for abusive or inappropriate conduct. Failure to comply with the [District's Bullying Prohibition Policy \(514\)](#), [Internet Acceptable Use & Safety Policy \(524\)](#), or the [Student Device Care and Use guidelines](#) may result in the loss of privilege to take the device home or use of the device altogether. The device is the property of the Jackson County Central School District and may be seized and reviewed at any time, in accordance with the [Search of Student Lockers, Desks, Personal Possessions, and student's person policy \(502\)](#). Devices that are dropped, tossed, hit, have items put on top of it, etc. are more likely to break. No case will protect them from this kind of misuse. Devices placed in backpacks with heavy books or when the backpack is regularly dropped on the floor, can eventually break due to repeated misuse.

**Student Responsibility for Protection and Care**

\_\_\_ I understand the student device must be kept in the school provided or approved case at all times. I can request permission from the technology office to purchase – at my expense – a different approved case. Tampering with or trying to remove the case can cause damage.

\_\_\_ I understand that I will be responsible for repairs. Even in the case were the damage was caused by another Individual because I am responsible for the care of this device.

\_\_\_ I understand that, if the device is broken beyond repair, I will be responsible for the FULL cost to replace.

\_\_\_ I understand that, I will be charged \$50.00 for a repair. I further understand, after two incidents of accidental damage, I will be responsible for the entire cost to repair or replace the device.

\_\_\_ I understand that, if the device is stolen, I must report the theft to the Technology Department and a Police Report must be completed. I will be responsible for the full price of the device if it is lost or stolen.

\_\_\_ I understand that the device will be returned at the end of each school year, along with the undamaged, school issued case, charger, and cord. The charge for any lost or damaged items will be: iPad - \$400; Chromebook - \$200.00; charger - \$38.00 (\$19 for charger base and/or \$19 for cord); case - \$20.00.

\_\_\_ I understand that:

- I may not remove or add Apps without Technology Department approval.
- I may not add personal e-mail addresses or personal Cloud accounts without approval.
- All pictures and videos on the School issued device may be viewed and removed at any time.
